Articulation Agreement

- This Articulation Agreement between New York Institute of Technology-New York
 Campuses and Nassau County Fire Police EMS Academy at NUMC confirms an agreement
 whereby students who successfully complete the course of study for the EMT-Paramedic
 Certificate Program will be awarded a maximum of 37 credits toward an NYIT bachelor's
 degree program.
- The award will apply to any student who is accepted based upon then-current NYIT
 admissions requirements and matriculates into an NYIT bachelor degree program.
 Students will receive up to 37 prior learning credits depending on the bachelor's degree
 program requirements.

- 3. The award is based on the Nassau County Fire Police EMS Academy at NUMC EMT-Paramedic Program from 2005 forward. Credit award for programs prior to 2005 will be assessed on a case-by-case basis.
- 4. The award will be recorded on NYIT transcripts as "Prior Learning" (PL) credit and the usual fee for this type of credit will be waived. All policies regarding transfer and prior learning credit outlined in the NYIT catalog are applicable to this Agreement. No duplication of credit will be awarded.
- 5. Nassau County Fire Police EMS Academy at NUMC students will forward to NYIT a final, official transcript verifying completion of the EMT-Paramedic Certificate program prior to

registering at NYIT. Cost of said transcript to be paid for by the student.

- 6. Nassau County Fire Police EMS Academy at NUMC agrees to provide students presently in its program with information pertaining to this Agreement, will list NYIT in any publication that refers to articulation agreements, and will allow NYIT to visit the Academy at least once each semester.
- 7. This articulation agreement will become effective once signed by both parties and will remain effective for a term of five years. Either NYIT or the Nassau County Fire Police EMS Academy at NUMC may withdraw from this Agreement at any time upon thirty days written notice to the other party, except that commitments made to students will be honored. Furthermore, this Agreement will be reviewed each year by both parties. The Agreement can be amended only in a writing signed by both parties.
- 8. This Agreement is not a legally binding contract and is not enforceable in a court of law or before an arbitral tribunal. In the event of a dispute, the parties agree to establish a process for an amicable resolution.

We look forward to a fruitful period of cooperation in an endeavor that will surely serve our students and our institutions.
